# Strawberry Upside-Down Skillet Cake



INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb. strawberries, sliced
- ½ cup brown sugar
- 2 Tbsp cornstarch
- 1 ¾ cups flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- ¾ cup sugar
- 2 eggs
- ½ cup sour cream
- ½ cup (1 stick) melted butter
- 1 tsp vanilla
- Vanilla ice cream (for serving)

DIRECTIONS

- 1 - Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease a 12” skillet, line with parchment, and grease again.
- 2 - Toss strawberries with brown sugar & corn starch. Spread evenly in skillet.
- 3 - In one bowl, mix flour, baking powder & salt. In another, whisk sugar, eggs, sour cream, butter and vanilla. Combine both and mix until just blended.
- 4 - Spread batter over berries. Use wet hands if needed.
- 5 - Bake ~35 min. until golden and a toothpick comes out clean.
- 6 - Cool 15 min. then invert onto a plate and remove parchment. Cool completely. Serve with ice cream.
