Celebrating 40 years of compassionate care

Giving with purpose.
This year marks a major milestone—40 years since Bayley Adult Day (Eldermount) first opened its doors on August 5, 1985. Since then, it has been a vital source of care, dignity, and community for older adults in the Cincinnati area. The program began with a vision from the Sisters of Charity to meet the growing needs of aging adults. In 1984, Sr. Phyllis Lambert was appointed to lead the effort, securing grants and overseeing renovations to launch one of Cincinnati’s first holistic adult day programs.

From Humble Beginnings to Life-Changing Impact
Starting with just nine participants three days a week, the program quickly grew. Today, it has served thousands of individuals and families—many of whom may not have had access to such essential support.

Bayley Adult Day offers more than daily care. It provides:

- Health monitoring and nursing support
- Social work and engaging activities
- Nutrition services and transportation
- A strong sense of purpose and community

A COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY

Caring for Creation

At Bayley Senior Care, our commitment to compassionate care extends to the environment. We’re proud to be recognized by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati as a Laudato Si’ Community, honoring our efforts to care for God’s creation in the spirit of Pope Francis’ encyclical Laudato Si’.

Across our campus, staff and residents are embracing sustainable practices: Campus-Wide Recycling Bayley at Green Township, our Independent Living Community, participates in a building-wide recycling program with containers on each floor for bottles, cans, and plastics. Our main campus is reducing its use of paper and implementing an electronic admissions process.

Eco-Friendly Dining
Our Dietary team recycles all cans and cardboard packaging and uses recycled products for carryout. They’ve also switched to fountain drinks to reduce aluminum waste.

Wellness & Fitness
The Wellness Center recycles paper and boxes, with containers inside and on the dock for collection. Memberships have transitioned to digital formats to reduce paper usage. Leftover food from events is packed in reusable containers.

Adult Day Program
The Adult Day Program now uses reusable cups and laundered shirt savers, replacing disposables. Monthly calendars are emailed instead of mailed, and all paper and boxes are recycled.

These efforts reflect Bayley’s commitment to environmental stewardship and faithful service. Thank you to everyone who plays a role in protecting the planet—one sustainable step at a time.

Theresa Humphrey’s Commitment to Sustainability

When Theresa Humphrey moved into Bayley Village in September 2016, she brought more than just her belongings—she brought a heart for service and a passion for sustainability.

Theresa quietly leads a recycling effort focused on giving plasticware a second life. Her inspiration began with her volunteer work at Tender Mercies and Our Lady of Victory’s food pantry, where volunteers had to supply everything from utensils to napkins. After noticing leftover high-quality plasticware at Bayley events, she had an idea: why not reuse it?

“I’d see the nice plasticware at events,” she said. “I thought, I can take that home, run it through the dishwasher, and pass it on to someone who needs it.”

For years now, Theresa has done just that. With help from fellow residents, she collects, cleans, and donates plasticware to local food pantries and community dinners—places like Camp Washington, St. Dominic’s,



and Shiloh Church. Her bright yellow bucket has become a familiar sight. “Some say I’ll need that yellow bucket in my casket,” she joked.

Theresa also reuses containers like Cool Whip tubs and takeout dishes, giving them to ministries that use them for leftovers or meal distribution—items that would otherwise end up in the landfill.

“It’s just one thing these places don’t have to buy,” she said. “And it gets used one more time.”

To Theresa, sustainability is simple: “It’s giving back to the earth, even just a little bit.”

She hopes others will be inspired to join her. “Even small acts can add up to something meaningful,” she said.
